Philosophy

Award Amounts

The amounts of the scholarships are: Bob Andrews \$1,500, Gene O'Brian \$1,500, Chuck Clutts \$1,500, Pat Maloney \$1,500 and Roy E Fritch \$1500.

Qualifications

1. Applicants must be a member of a Circle K and be in good standing with their home club, district, and international
2. Applicants must meet the institutions minimum standards for enrollment during the academic year in which the scholarship is issued.
3. Applicants must be enrolled and in good standing with to which the scholarship will be paid.
4. Applicants enrolled in a technical or vocational school will be enrolled in 12 hours or more of school credit.
5. Applicant may have received a scholarship in a previous college year; however, the applicant is not qualified to receive two scholarships in same year.

Application Procedures

1. All applicants must submit the following:
 - a. A completed application form.
 - b. Submit an essay addressing the question "how Circle K enhanced my leadership skills." (This essay should be limited to two double-spaced, Font Size 12, typed pages).
 - c. One (1) letter of recommendation from a Circle K Advisor.
 - d. A letter or verification concerning the student's enrolment status from the Dean of Students/Registrar.
 - e. All the above must be included with the application to be considered.
2. The application, essay, and letter listed above must be submitted to Pacific Northwest Kiwanis Foundation Board Member Richard Johnson, 3825 Copper Pond, Anacortes, WA 98221.
